At the Solihull Bible Learning Centre we try to encourage people to read the Bible because of its wonderful, life-giving message. Sometimes this is easy, but sometimes people who have never read the Bible find it difficult to start.

Recently we put just outside the BLC copies of a book called ***Life's Biggest Questions*** which passers-by could take free of charge. We were astonished and delighted when within 6 weeks we had given away 300 copies!

Why did so many people take a copy of this book? What is it about the title which appeals to people?

We started giving the books away not long after the Grenfell fire tragedy, which is the kind of desperately sad event which makes people think about how fragile life is. Then there have been the dreadful pictures of the war, famine and disease in the Yemen, Kim Jong-Un's launch of missiles which may now be able to unleash nuclear war on America, the unpredictable actions of Donald Trump, on-going terrorist attacks and the uncertainties of Brexit. Suddenly we don't feel safe anymore!

This raises big questions which the book sets out to answer from the Bible:

What are we living for? What are we looking for? Is there a future for the world or are we drifting towards oblivion? Why am I here? Where did I come from? Where am I headed?

Clearly there is a deep yearning amongst people for answers to these questions.

Choices - We can do one of three things:

- 1)** We can eat, drink and be merry for tomorrow we die and hope that the problems will go away
- 2)** We can join an environmental or protest movement and try to find a better future by human efforts and persuade ourselves that things can only get better
- 3)** Or we can turn to the one book with the answers and with hope for the world and for each of us.

We think the sensible move is to give the Bible a chance to tell us what God is doing about Life's biggest questions.

So we are redoubling our efforts to help people to know and understand the Bible at the Bible Learning Centre and in a new four week introductory course on Life's big questions.
